

CPED Training Programs

Title of Training	Course Description
1. Senior Executive Certificate Course for Strategic Management of Anti-Corruption Program	Designed to deepen and broaden the understanding of the causes and effects of corruption and its negative consequences on the well-being of the nation and citizenry; strengthen the technical know-how and skills in corruption prevention, detection, investigation, prosecution and community education; and develop an effective anti-corruption strategic plan drawing lessons from the best (and worst) practices in the region.
2. Project on Developing Pro-Poor Governance Knowledge Capability: Use of Continuous Improvement and Benchmarking (CIB) and Citizen Report Card (CRC) Techniques	Utilizing two approaches (CIB and CRC) developed in 2005, it has sought to improve transparency and accountability in the delivery of public service in the Philippines. Two modalities were applied: involvement of an educational institution and the selection of public services to strengthen the capability of stakeholders and improve service delivery performance with an end result of building capacities to support the delivery of other public services in the country/
3. Workshop on Strategic Management of Anti-Corruption Program	The course generally seeks to identify the root causes of corruption and the practical methods to effectively manage its eradication through a sound and workable plan of action.
4. Strengthening the Capability of Philippine Anti-Corruption Agencies on Results-Based Program and Project Management	This course on project development and management has been designed to ensure that the Fund is judiciously used and that interventions will lead to successful implementation of reform measures against corruption. The course aimed at providing the participants with the necessary knowledge and practical tools to enable them to think of, plan, manage, monitor and evaluate anti-corruption projects.
5. Protecting the Integrity of the Judiciary	The program seeks to assist the Supreme Court (SC) in identifying and addressing institutional weaknesses or vulnerabilities that impinge on the overall performance and productivity of its administrative support structure. It involves a structured approach to diagnose and address critical problems in

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	the judiciary that erode public trust and confidence. It entails a package of interventions to improve the integrity of the judiciary by strengthening its institutional capacity to fight and prevent corruption. The outputs include a communication strategy; performance and integrity enhancement measures; a strategy for sustaining initiatives and gains; and a guidebook on the package.
6. Executive Course on Strategic Planning and Management of an Effective Corruption Prevention Program	There are 4 themes: Recognizing and preventing corruption; Applying corruption prevention tools and techniques; Enhancing performance and integrity; and Best practices in corruption prevention.
7. Training Course on Strategic Planning and Management of an Effective Anti-Corruption Program	The first training program in support of the Center for Asian Integrity (CAI), the course has been designed and implemented for selected representatives of government, the private sector and civil society. The course generally seeks to enhance the professional competencies of the participants to effectively manage the fight against corruption. Particularly deals with effective corruption preventive measures; and partnerships and networking strategies with government, business sector, civil society, and other overseas anti-corruption and law enforcement agencies to strengthen anti-corruption efforts.
8. Promoting the Formulation and Enhancement of Code of Conduct (CoC) by Government Agencies in the Philippines: Mentoring and Coaching Program	The program generally seeks to assist the participating agencies (enhance/formulate their CoCs. Agencies with CoCs review their respective CoCs, identify areas of improvement and draft the necessary enhancements, while agencies without CoCs draft effective and acceptable CoCs. Follow-on activities are prepared to ensure monitoring the adoption of the new CoCs by the respective agencies.
9. Policy Analysis Course for Senior Officials and Technical Staff of the Department of Interior and Local Government	CPED conducted two separate policy analysis courses for the senior officials and technical staff of the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG). The three-day senior executive course program precedes the eight-day course for the technical staff of the Department.

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10. Congressional Internship Program for Young Muslim Leaders (Academic Course on Public Policy Development and Advocacy)	The course is an introductory exploration of public policy analysis. It provides the students with basic concepts and practical methods of public policy analysis. It also deals with accessing data sources and weighing the utility of policy relevant information.
