CLCD Monthly Report

GCV FIELD MONITORING

THE CENTER for Leadership, Citizenship and Democracy (CLCD) is now conducting its monitoring on good citizenship initiatives. Programs/projects/activities spawned through the series of National Congress on Good Citizenship (NCGC) (2006-2008) will be reviewed as part of the agreements during the 3rd Congress in October 2008.

Since 2006, representatives from various sectors including the academe, business, civil society and government have participated in the annual NCGCs held at the University of the Philippines Diliman, Quezon City. The U.P. National College of Public Administration and Governance-Center for Leadership, Citizenship and Democracy (UPNCPAG-CLCD) serves as the secretariat and co-convenor of NCGC.

The Center has identified advocates in good citizenship endeavors. A monitoring review of initiatives promoting good citizenship values (GCVs) is scheduled in Bayawan City, Cebu, and Davao. The period for monitoring is February-March 2009.

GAWAD KALINGA STUDY

THE UPNCPAG through its Center for Leadership, Citizenship and Democracy (CLCD) is a partner-institution to the Gawad Kalinga Builders' Institutes (GKBIs) established in 2007. Among the commitments of UPNCPAG-CLCD to GKBI is the conduct of research on Gawad Kalinga (GK)—its distinguishing features as a development model, its contribution to society, the various aspects of its implementation and management, and other issues.

CLCD is host to UPNCPAG GKBI and has conferred a Distinguished Leader Fellow on Mr. Tony Meloto.

In pursuit of the objectives of GKBI, CLCD is currently conducting field research that involves interviews with GK beneficiaries and leaders. The CLCD team identified GK community sites for its field interviews, which are scheduled on the following dates: 26-28 February 2009 for Bayawan City; 9-11 March 2009 for Cebu; and 13-15 March 2009 for Davao.

NAPOLCOM TERMINAL REPORT

THE TERMINAL REPORT for the two-day training for National Police Commission (NAPOLCOM) officials held in 2008 was submitted on 17 February 2009.

PAGC WORKSHOP
