Project Developments

The Center will be partnering with Tambuyog Development Center for its proposed project on “Revitalizing Foreshore Areas and Building Viable Enterprises towards Developing Assets of Coastal Communities”. This concept note for the proposed proposal has been approved by the European Commission for the submission of a full proposal. Once approved, the project will be funded by the Small Projects Facility Phase 2 (SPF 2) of EU.



The overall objective of the project is to contribute to improving governance as underlying condition for reaching the MDG. The project intends to improve cooperation and partnerships between and among local government units, government agencies, communities and the business sectors in coastal communities.





People Management Training for the Office of the Solicitor General (OSG) Lawyers and Non-Lawyers

CPED is making final arrangements for the conduct of a pilot training program on people management for the Office of the Solicitor-General (OSG). The training program is intended to enhance the managerial knowledge and skills of 20 Assistant Solicitor-Generals (ASGs). The training program design has been submitted to OSG for their review.

Sustainable transport policy

CPED will be offering its expertise to assist the Department of Transportation and Communications (DOTC) in the conduct of a project on harmonization and modernization of land transportation laws, rules and regulations. There is an existing Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the DOTC and UP Diliman for the conduct of joint research and development activities on sustainable transport policy. The MOU took effect in January 2007 and will remain valid until 2010 (See attached MOU and MOA for the creation of the Joint Committee between DOTC and UPD).
