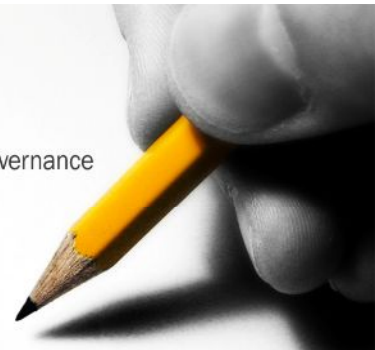

9th Cycle of the Congressional Internship Program for Young Muslim Leaders (Academic Course on Public Policy Development and Advocacy)

The 9th Cycle of the CIPYML program concluded last December 2009. All 25 interns successfully completed the course requirements of the program and received their certificate of completion last 27 November at the Audio-Visual Room in NCPAG and 01 December at the Dusit Thani Hotel in Makati.

People Management Training for the Office of the Solicitor General (OSG) Lawyers and Non-Lawyers

CPED is making final arrangements for the conduct of a pilot training program on people management for the Office of the Solicitor-General (OSG). The objective of the program is to enhance the participants' competencies and capabilities in managing the organization particularly on the different perspectives, paradigms, models and dynamics of leadership and management. The program will cater to 32 Assistant Solicitor-Generals (ASGs) and division-chiefs.

Clark International Airport Corporation (CIAC) Awareness Building Seminar on Ethical Standard

CPED will conduct an Awareness Building Seminar on Ethical Standards for the employees of the CIAC. This seminar aims to provide a venue to have a clear understanding of the existing laws and policies that guide ethical behaviour of employees. This will serve as a basis for integrating the moral recovery program in government operations.

The seminar will be a half-day session which will be conducted in three batches for approximately 300 participants from all CIAC levels. The final arrangements of the program are underway.
